

Application Process

Confidentiality will be maintained throughout the application process. This information is necessary to ensure a successful placement on the part of the family and Glory Community.

- 1) Inquiry made by family
- 2) Set up family interview with Jim and Sandy Hembd, including resident applicant.
 - General information and Glory Community information given
 - Initial Application given/or downloaded from website
 - Tour of home (if applicable)
- 3) Completed Initial Application for Admission is returned to Glory Community
- 4) Admissions Committee processes initial application and may request additional information.
- 5) Admissions Committee determines whether to continue the process
- 6) Family meets with Financial Planner
- 7) Enrollment Procedure Packet is provided to the family to be completed and returned to Glory Community. Also the Glory Community Handbook and a copy of the House Rules and Code of Conduct is given for signature at this time.
- 8) Enrollment papers returned with:

\$1000	One time, nonrefundable, intake & processing fee
\$2500	First month's tuition
- 9) Family given date for admission to Glory Community
